Our history

As an ammunition depot for the NATO Rhine Army, the BILSTER BERG had served as a storage facility for explosive substances since 1970. 10 years after it was taken out of commission, the vision was born to build a racetrack with the latest standards and the highest demands on the deserted terrain. A truly massive project without any public funds and with many concerns. From the very beginning, many minds and hands were actively involved in the approximately ten-year planning phase. Among them were the internationally active race track planner Hermann Tilke and the racing legend Walter Röhrl. After two years of construction, the area with its extraordinary track was officially opened on June 1, 2013: BILSTER BERG was born!

A word about safety in advance.

No matter which driving experience you want to realize at the BILSTER BERG: Safety always takes pole position! This is helped by 26 HD cameras and up to 35 observation or flag posts with radio. The Electronic Marshall System provides additional safety during your brand event. In addition, safety cars and a towing crane truck are available for the security of your guests.

Test

Your values matter.

On the BILSTER BERG, you test under the highest security standards, up to and including secrecy status. The exceptional location and the highest security measures for access to the entire site ensure discretion. This affords you the opportunity to test even the most sensitive products, perfectly shielded from the outside world.

The BILSTER BERG fulfils a wide range of requirements for the successful execution of the planned tests. 4.2 kilometres - divisible into the 1.8 kilometre long west loop and the 2.4 kilometre long east loop. 44 crests and dips, 19 turnes, downhill grades of up to 26 percent, uphill grades of up to 21 percent and a cumulative elevation change of more than 200 meters. On the dynamics area you will find the optimal conditions for precise tests. With a total area of 320 x 60 meters, tests can be carried out on three levels. These can be irrigated separately or together. In addition, there is also a skidpad, which can also be irrigated.





Trackday

Driving pleasure redefined. Passion meets safety.

Trackdays at BILSTER BERG are organized driving events to improve vehicle control. The BILSTER BERG is one of the most challenging natural circuits in Europe and places the highest demands on man and machine. The area opens up to impressive race track experiences for you. In addition to the driving fun, your safety is obviously the top priority. Therefore, the track follows a safety concept that is strictly based on the guidelines from the FIA and is regularly reviewed by the DMSB.

Training





The Offroad Hall

The offroad hall at the offroad course can be used in many ways thanks to its three-part layout. It offers a washing hall and a hydraulic lifting platform for tire changes and vehicle checks. In the middle of the hall is an exhibition area where vehicles can be driven on. In the 3rd part, the lounge area, a Bullerjan wood-burning stove, cosy furniture and optional catering invite you to linger, especially in the cold season. The large glass front provides plenty of light.



Environmental protection & sustainability at BILSTER BERG

Protecting the biodiversity of the Weserbergland was a matter close to the heart of the BILSTER BERGS from the very beginning. For this reason, numerous effective concepts were discussed together with the experts from the Bureau for Faunistics in Cologne, Bureau Kortemeier and the Lower Landscape Authority already during the planning phase. These ultimately made it possible for the BILSTER BERG to strike a balance between economic operation of an automotive testing and presentation track and the natural biodiverity of the region. This was achieved above all by implementing habitat compensation measures: for the resident dormice, 40 dormouse boxes were erected on the BILSTER BERG, which serve as an ideal shelter for the rodents, which are protected throughout Europe

By creating two new biotopes, the great crested newts were resettled, as were the various rare bat species, for which 100 replacement bat roosts were established, which, like the dormouse boxes, were measured by GPS device. Galloway cattle grazing on the CEF (Continuous Ecological Functionality) areas and several bee colonies that live in beehives directly on the premises complete the biodiversity at the BILSTER BERG.

15 Environment

Environmental management system.

Environmental protection and sustainability have been a priority since the opening of the test and presentation track in June 2013, which is why a certified environmental management system, or EMS for short, was set up. This means that the BILSTER BERG is committed to sustainable environmental protection. Thanks to the EMS, all legal requirements and guidelines can be better implemented and monitored, for example the compensation of CO² emissions caused by the driving activities on the BILSTER BERG or the permanent undercutting of the noise quota.



When purchasing raw and auxiliary materials, ecological criteria are taken into account and preference is given to suppliers who place a similarly high value on environmental protection. The BILSTER **BERG** is currently following transformation processes the automotive industry and is investing in improving the infrastructure. Renewable energy and a healthy energy mix also play a role here. Renewable energy is already being used at the BILSTER BERG thanks to a wind power plant that has been in operation for years.

Future developments.

The company will continue to invest in its development in the future. Following the successful expansion of photovoltaic systems with a total output of two megawatts on the roofs of the plant, the focus is now on further projects, such as the technical renewal of the route monitoring system, the installation of additional electric charging stations and the construction of a hydrogen filling station.

"Environmental protection is an important goal in our company. The effort to protect the environment is an obligation for our company towards our customers, business partners, fellow human beings and future generations," says Hans-Jürgen von Glasenapp, Managing Director at BILSTER BERG. "The results of active environmental protection at the BILSTER BERG are very satisfactory. It was the right decision to take the more complex route to protect our environment from the outset. And thanks to the large number of compensatory activities that we intend to further expand in the future, there is absolutely no contradiction between this and our work as a test and presentation track."
